Here is the absolute winner, according to Yenii. Give it a try. We love the name, and chances are....you already have all the ingredients in the pantry. May this delicious cake bring you joy and warmth and all the things for which we are yearning in 2021.

PANTRY CRUMB CAKE

(recipe from NY Times Cooking)

Ingredients:

Topping: ½ cup (110 grams) packed light or dark brown sugar

14 cup (55 grams) unsalted butter, melted (dairy-free substitute: 14 cup unrefined coconut oil)

¼ cup (30 grams) all-purpose flour

¼ cup (20 grams) old-fashioned oats

1 teaspoon ground spices - cinnamon, cardamom, or a combination

¼ teaspoon fine sea salt

Cake: 1½ cups (190 grams) all-purpose flour

1 teaspoon baking powder

¼ teaspoon baking soda

½ teaspoon fine sea salt

½ cup (115 grams) unsalted butter, at room temperature (dairy-free substitute: ½ cup unrefined coconut oil)

½ cup (100 grams) granulated sugar

2 large eggs

2 teaspoons vanilla extract

3 cup (160 ml) sour cream, yogurt or nondairy yogurt (dairy-free substitute: So Delicious plain coconut yogurt)

1 teaspoon grated lemon or orange zest

1 cup fresh fruit, or frozen and thawed, such as blueberries, raspberries, cherries

Directions:

- 1. Heat oven to 350oF. Butter an 8- or 9-inch square pan (or round springform pan).
- 2. Preparing the topping: Add all the topping ingredients to a medium bowl. Use a rubber spatula until they all start to clump together. Squish or roll the mixture into mostly large crumbs with some smaller ones.
- 3. Preparing the cake: In a medium bowl, whisk together the flour, baking powder, baking soda and salt until combined.
- 4. In the bowl of an electric mixer fitted with the paddle attachment, beat the butter and sugar at medium speed until creamy and smooth, 1 to 2 minutes. Beat in the eggs, one at a time, then beat in vanilla extract. Add half of the flour mixture, then beat in the sour cream/yogurt. Add the remaining flour, and mix, just until incorporated, scraping down the sides of the bowl. Fold in the zest and fruit.
- 5. Pour the batter into the baking pan and top evenly with the crumbs. Bake for 45-50 minutes, or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean. Let the cake cool in the pan.


The Lake View Lodge is also just a quick walk to the Finley Point State Park for swimming, boat launching, and lake fun.


